## TREND SETTERS



#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. On three feet of thread, pick up PB, SB, two PB, SB, PB. Pass through the first PB added to form a loop. Tie a knot. Pass through SB, two PB, SB, PB.
- 2. Add six SB. Pass through PB, SB, two PB, SB, PB, the six SB just added, PB, SB, PB.
- 3. Pick up SB, two PB, SB. Pass through PB, SB. Add R3. Pass through SB, PB, SB, PB.
- 4. Repeat Step 3 until all PB are added.
- 5. At the end of the bracelet, pass through PB, SB. Add the last R3, pass through SB, PB.
- 6. Add six SB. Secure the thread by passing through the loop again before tying off.
- 7. Attach a clasp to the seed bead loops using jump rings.

#### **MATERIALS**

46 Pinch Beads 5/3mm (PB) 22 Rondelle 3mm (R3)

11° TOHO Round Seed Beads (SB)

2 Jump Rings

Clasp of Choice

Thread of Choice

Creates approx 6" bracelet. Each segment adds about .25" to the length.




