INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Note: String the B so they all face the same direction. On 12" of thread, add A, B; repeat eleven times, leaving a 4" tail. Pass through all beads again (not shown) and tie a knot against the tail to form a ring. Tie off.
- 2. Component jewelry ideas:

Earrings: Make two rings and use jump rings or beaded loops to connect them to earwires.

Pendant: String rings directly onto a chain, or stitch a small bail off of a Demi Round.

Bracelet: Connect multiple rings end to end with loops made of seed beads.

MATERIALS

TOHO 6° Demi Rounds (A)Teacups (B)TOHO One-G Thread

Component as instructed measures 1/2" wide.
